

What do we do?

Your local Care and Repair Service is a partnership between Lochalsh & Skye Housing Association and The Highland Council, and is in place to provide free information and advice to homeowners and private tenants aged over 65, or of any age with a disability, who need repairs, improvements or adaptations to their homes. Our Care and Repair Team has been vetted by Disclosure Scotland and will be able to show you their identification badge when they knock on your door.

How can we help?

Care and Repair can offer advice and assistance or can act on your behalf by:

- Organising surveys and drawings;
- Obtaining prices for work;
- Applying for grants towards the work;
- Assisting with loans and other funding applications;
- Organising the works; and
- Approaching other agencies.

What can we do for you?

Adaptations

Care and Repair can help with adaptations to your home to suit your needs:

- Works to improve safety and access inside or outside the building.
- Works to improve personal care or health needs.

Your needs will be assessed by Health and Social Care staff and their recommendations will form the basis of the package of works we can offer to you.

Repairs and Improvements

Care and Repair can advise on and assist with the repair or improvement of your home.

- Structural instability
- Dampness
- Rot/structural infestation
- Defective electrical supply
- Lack of thermal insulation
- Inadequate foul/surface drainage
- Inadequate water supply
- Lack of toilet/basin, bath/shower
- Inadequate light/ventilation

Your property will be assessed by a Technical Officer and their recommendations will form the basis of the package of works we can offer to you.
